 Persons Age 55 and Over Living in a Condominium by Age Group and Sex

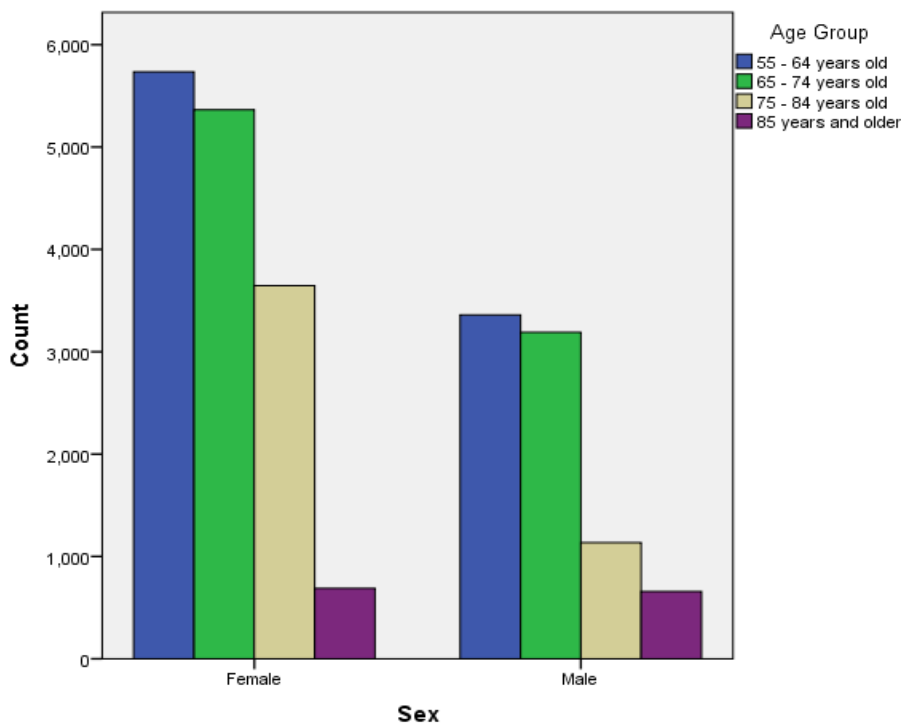
